The **Executive Committee** consists of the Officers and the five Area Executives










County Office Advocacy Committee

- Served a vital role in the development of COC Orientation/Training for COC members, to provide a consistent and comprehensive training/orientation for COC members in all states







Legislative

Legislative Wins



- The **2020** FSA budget enjoyed a significant increase of 39 million above the **2019** spending level and \$107 million higher that the President's proposal.
 - The bill included \$35 million earmarked for hiring, county office staff and farm loan officers to address staffing shortages
- COVID 19 paid sick leave 80 hours of leave -Employees have been able to utilize this benefit during the COVID-19 pandemic
- CARES Act funding included:
 - \$3 million for hiring temporary employees and paying for overtime
 - An additional \$14 billion to boost CCC funding
 - \$9.5 billion for assisting livestock, dairy, and specialty crop producers



Legislative

NASCOE Policy Works

- NASCOE worked with the Administration to have the Paid Parental Leave benefit extended to County Office employees so all FSA employees could enjoy this great new benefit.
- NASCOE has sent letters of support for legislation introduced by Senator Chris Van Hollen (D-MD) that would make the Executive Order tax deferral program optional for federal employees
- NASCOE hosted a Leadership Development Program October 24-25, 2019 in Dallas, Texas. This was an excellent opportunity for aspiring leaders to come together to learn about NASCOE and find ways to get involved so they can use their talents and interest to further promote county office employee rights and benefits while developing key leadership skills
- NASCOE President Brandon Wilson participated in a roundtable discussion on staffing and resources in front of the House Subcommittee on Nutrition and Forestry.
- President Brandon Wilson met with former House Agriculture Committee Chairperson Collin Peterson (D-MN) on two occasions to discuss County Office staffing and resource issues.





Membership

- Convened a NASCOE Membership Work Group meeting
 - formulated ideas and plans to effectively recruit and retain NASCOE members,
 - also enhancing the organizational processes of NASCOE to better meet the needs of all County Office employees.

- The updated NASCOE Membership Training was presented during the membership breakout session of the 2020 NASCOE Virtual Convention.
 - This training is available on the NASCOE website and will be reviewed with all new and current membership chairpersons.

- An automated NASCOE
 Membership Referral
 Form was created.
 - When submitted, an e-mail with the potential member's information is sent to the respective Area membership chairperson
 - Area Membership chairs forward to the applicable state membership chairperson for contact and processing.
- The Area membership committee members worked with states to submit NASCOE dues in a timely manner.
 There will soon be potentially newer ways to pay dues digitally.
- The membership committee established a preliminary system for states to use in tracking new hires in all states. This was provided to all states.

Programs / Negotiations

- Received and processed 150 program submissions from 30 states; up from 7 programs submissions in 2018-2019
- FSA implemented many program submissions during the 2019-2020 NASCOE fiscal year
- Designed a Program Submission / Negotiation Item Fact Sheet
- National Programs Chair traveled to Washington D.C. in February 2020 and met face to face with all FSA program divisions
- Common submission form created for Program and Negotiation Submissions

- Developed the NASCOE Information database with NASCOE Leadership
