

HONORARY LIFE MEMBER CRITERIA

A person is eligible for Honorary Life Membership if the person was a member of his or her state association since the second year of formation or from the first full membership year of employment until retirement and an annuity is earned. Honorary Life Membership for RIF'ed employees is limited to those retaining their Civil Service Retirement Rights.

States must certify to the above at the time a request is submitted to the National Membership Chairperson for recognition as an Honorary Lifetime Member. NASCOE will send an Honorary Lifetime Membership Certificate to the recipient.

If any state has a person they would like to be recognized with Honorary Life Membership and the person does not meet the present requirements, the state may request a waiver through the NASCOE Membership Committee Chairperson, with the proposed lifetime member's knowledge and consent, detailing the person's membership history and listing the reasons they feel the person should be an Honorary Life Member.

This request for waiver will be acted upon by the Executive Committee at the next scheduled board meeting and the state will be notified of approval or disapproval.
