The NASCOE Membership Committee would like to remind everyone of the many opportunities they have to recognize deserving co-workers and retirees with an award! Please take a few moments to review the below available awards and submit the necessary forms found at the below website to recognize our eligible members!

- **Honorary Lifetime Membership Awards** are available to eligible retirees throughout the year. A person is eligible for Honorary Life Membership if they were a member of his or her state association since the first full membership year of employment until retirement and an annuity is earned. Please submit these applications, certified by your state association Secretary/Treasurer, to me as soon as possible so they can make use of their free registration fees benefit for the annual NASCOE National Convention.
- **NASCOE Membership Consecutive Year Awards** are available for those individuals and county offices who have had 25 years or more of continuous NASCOE membership. Eligible individuals receive a NASCOE pin with the years of continuous membership and a certificate. The county offices who are 100% membership for these eligible years will receive a continuous plaque at the National Convention held this year in Savannah, Georgia. Please send your award request form, certified by your state association Secretary/Treasurer, by **June 15th**.
